## OPEN LETTER TO VALLEY ELECTED OFFICIALS REGARDING PLANNED VISIT OF TRUMP TO RGV

## Dear Elected Officials:

With the news of the reported visit to the Rio Grande Valley by President Trump, we are called to ask that you speak out against bringing his inciteful rhetoric to our community and demand that this planned trip be cancelled immediately.

Our community along the beautiful Rio Grande represents exactly what Trump's base fears. He will use our community as an example of "what will become of the US" unless he and his "patriots" rail against it. Our home, our culture, our collective being of which we are so unbelievably proud is going to be held up as evidence of a liberal leadership, all that Trump and his base are against.

This planned trip by the President is nothing more than a stunt to stoke the energy of his supporters. There is no official purpose for him to come here now, at a time when Congress has filed articles of impeachment for a second time, on the heels of unbelievable threats to our democracy at his instigation.
